Hello there everyone!

Since my last note to everyone things have drastically changed in our world. COVID-19 has brought with it many restrictions and alterations to how we typically go about business and live our lives. It is important that we continue to listen to our health officials. I hope that we are nearing the end like all of you, however only working together will we be able to see the end sooner than later.

Spring brush pick-up will begin on May 18th. There are new regulations for Brush Pick up this year. We ask that brush be placed in bundles and tied with twine. All bundles



should not exceed 60 pounds in weight, 6 feet in length, and 2 feet in width. Brush limbs should not exceed 6" in diameter. Our Town workers are very important to us and these requirements will ensure that brush pick-up is done in a safer, easier, and more efficient manner while still providing brush pick-up service to all Grottoes residents. Please put your bundles out beside the roadway and the Town will pick up. This is a very busy time of year for our maintenance staff and we appreciate your patience as we work on Brush Pick-up. If you have questions regarding this service please contact the Town office at 249-5896.

I would also like to thank our Waste Water Operator Bob Smith, known as Wastewater Bob, for his time working for the Town.

Wastewater Bob retired on April 30th. Bob has worked for the Town running our Treatment plant for 20 years and is an incredible person. Thank you Bob for your service to our Town. I'd also like to welcome our new Operator, Scott Balsley.

Lastly, we are continuing to monitor the COVID-19 situation. Some Town events have had to be canceled and we will continue to update on our website and Facebook page as we near future events.


